Chairman Hoffman called the meeting to order and opened with the pledge at 5:00 PM. He then asked JoAnn to read the January meeting minutes. Road report: Dan reported the roads are looking good right now. He also reported that he is applying for disaster damage from the ice storm that caused trees to be over the road. He estimated that it's going to cost around \$20,000 to clear all the brush and trees from the right aways. Treasurers report: Marian reported a starting balance of \$526,642.40. Income being \$517,972.68. Expenses \$466,429.78. Leaving a balance of \$510,116.03. Brian made a motion to accept the treasures report Dan seconded motion carried.

Chuck Zenner's report: Chuck reported on the county's cost reduction of \$500,000. He also reported that it's going to be hard to do without cutting services which he is not in favor of. He also asked if the town had any suggestions too, please let him know.
